– V – A	What happened? Where did it happen? Are people in danger? Who reports (name, phone number)?
4. 5	Safeguard Measures
	Warn persons at risk Get people in need of help to safety Close doors and windows, turn off gas and electricity if necessary (red safety switch on yellow background next to lab exits) Use marked escape routes (escape & rescue plan between rooms 313 and 311, 415 and 416) Do not use the lift in case of fire
5. N	Make extinguishing attempts
– L – F – E	use existing extinguishing devices Fire extinguishers are located in Rooms 310, 132, 426 and 431 Emergency showers are located in Rooms 310, 416, 418, 422 und 426
6. F	First Aid Measures
