The t.e.a.m. basecamp programme is aimed exclusively at female doctoral and postdoctoral researchers in coordinated DFG joint projects at Leipzig University. Participation is possible at any time. The participation fee is covered by the DFG equality funds of the joint projects. This programme line is integrated into the current six programme lines, which cover all qualification levels from student to postdoc. An openness to networking with female researchers from the other t.e.a.m. programme lines is therefore desirable. In order to make this possible, appointments will be announced well in advance wherever possible. At the start of the programme, mentees receive a briefing to help them understand mentoring and their role in the programme. Project management and coordination are available to provide support throughout the duration of the programme.
