## Conditions of participation

The t.e.a.m. basecamp programme is aimed exclusively at female doctoral and postdoctoral researchers in coordinated DFG joint projects at Leipzig University. Participation is possible at any time. The participation fee is covered by the DFG equality funds of the joint projects. This programme line is integrated into the current six programme lines, which cover all qualification levels from student to postdoc.
