To Ukrainian prospective students and students affected by the war in Ukraine interested in medical degrees (Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Veterinary Medicine)

Important information on the application for an advanced semester

First of all, please note that that the <u>chances of admission to the medical</u> <u>subjects are unfortunately low</u>. The number of applications far exceeds the number of study places. In some higher semesters of study there are no free places available and therefore no application for the respective advanced semester can be admitted.

We kindly ask you to take this into account before you apply for a higher semester of study in a medical program at Leipzig University. You may be able to study a medical degree (in English language) in another EU country.

Important: All medical degrees at Leipzig University are only offered in German. Therefore, you are supposed to submit a sufficient <u>German-</u> <u>language proof at level C1 or C2</u> at the time of your application. Please find the accepted German language certificates for your studies on our website.

Obtaining credits of previous studies

Under certain conditions, when enrolling on an undergraduate degree at Leipzig University it is possible to start in a higher semester of study. If you have already earned credits in the same or a similar degree program, you can apply to have these prior academic achievements taken into account. You will require a **credits form**, which you enclose with your application.

If you wish to apply for a higher semester of study on the degree programs <u>Medicine, Dentistry or Pharmacy</u>, you can obtain the necessary credits form from the competent **Landesprüfungsamt**. Please apply for these credits by submitting certified copies of your transcripts and degrees of your previous studies.

Please apply via the <u>uni-assist application portal</u> first. Afterwards, kindly apply for <u>recognition of your previous studies</u> at the competent examination office of Veterinary Medicine at Leipzig University. Please take the relevant application deadlines for it into account.

How and when may I apply?

Application cycle

The application cycle through the University Application Service for International Students uni-assist e.V., Berlin lasts for the winter term from the beginning of April until 15 July, for the summer intake from the beginning of November until 15 January.

Step 1: Online application via uni-assist

If you intend to apply at Leipzig University, apply online via uni-assist's application portal. You do not need to submit any certified copies.

Step 2: Upload of application documents

Upload all necessary documents (see below) electronically via "My Applications" – "Documents". Identify the documents clearly in German or English.

Step 3: Answering open mandatory questions

Answer all open mandatory questions and submit your application electronically.

Schritt 4: Transferring the processing fee

Pay the processing fee of 75 EUR to uni-assist. All information regarding the fees and the payment can be found at uni-assist's webpage.

Information about the uni-assist application

Uni-assist checks whether your application comprises all necessary documents. In addition, they determine whether you meet the admission requirements. Leipzig University decides if you will get admitted into the intended study program.

Application documents

A full application normally comprises the following documents:

- Credits form from the Landesprüfungsamt or Credits form from Leipzig University (Veterinary Medicine!)
- 2. Secondary School Certificate, including grades
- 3. Proof of university entrance examination (if applicable)
- 4. **Proof of obtained university degrees**, including transcript of records (e.g. Bachelor, Diploma)
- 5. Proof of German-language proficiency at level C1 or C2

Your documents need to be submitted in the original language as well as a translation into German or English by a sworn translator.
